- All students need to be picked up from school promptly at 3.00pm or enrolled at After School Care.
- In order to ensure the safety of all our students on our school site and in line with WH&S requirements, external gates remain locked in the mornings until 8.15am and until 2.45pm in the afternoons.
- Please meet your child outside in the playground at the designated meeting place at the end of the day.
